Cabernet Sauvignon

Deep and dry blackberry fruit accented by tobacco and cassis notes.
- 2003 **Astrale e Terra, Arcturus (Atlas Peak, Napa Valley, California) 10/40**
Aromas of ripe plum, raspberry and violet. Bright, red fruit flavors with hints of spice, cedar and black olive on the finish. Balanced with soft, lingering, tannins.
- 2004 **Sawbuck (Mendocino County, California) 10/40**
Aromas of red raspberries and dusty chocolate with hints of toasty oak and spice. Soft in the palate with berries, cocoa, spice and silky tannins
- 2005 **Shingleback (McLaren Vale, Australia) 12/48**
Lean and vibrant, with a strong red pepper character weaving through the currant and spice flavors.
- 2006 **Oxford Landing (South Australia, Australia) 7/28** 
Deep crimson in color with blackberry, plum and cedar aromas with hints of eucalyptus and violets. Dark berry fruit flavors and spice with lingering tannins.
- 2008 **Leese-Fitch (California) 8/32** 
Nose of bourbon-soaked cherries, chocolate, and cedar, complemented by flavors of red currants, blackberry cobbler, and subtle notes of walnuts, wild game, and rich French oak.
- 2007 **Avalon (Napa Valley, California) 8/32** 
Deep garnet color. Aromas of raspberry, blackberry, mint, and black cherries. Tannins are fine and chalky with a hint of oak.

Generous aroma of black cherry, currant and plum. On the palate fruit flavors with blackberry, round mouth feel and finish.
- 2004 **Mont Gras Reserva Cabernet/Syrah blend (Colchagua Valley, Chile) 9/36** 
Aromas of plum and cherry with a hint of vanilla, berry, spice and cocoa flavors.
- 2005 **Silver Palm (North Coast, California) 10/40** 
Scents of blackberry, coffee, chocolate and cinnamon, dark fruit flavors enriched by coffee, chocolate and vanilla tones.
- 2006 **Folie à Deux (Napa Valley, California) 10/40** 
Good structure and balance. Chocolate with layers of blackberry and black cherry on the palate while tannins provide a nice finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, cont.

- 2004 Neil Ellis (South Africa) 13/52 
Deep red, purple in colour, the wine has high - toned blackcurrent, violet and cedar aromas with touches of mint, so typical of a Jonkershoek wine. A rich, ripe opulent but youthful palate has plummy fruit, a background of new oak and fine tannins.
- 2008 Sharecropper's (Columbia Valley, Washington) 14/56 
Smoky blackberry and dark cherry aromas. Juicy black fruit flavors, especially cassis, with dried herbs and earth on the slightly chewy finish.
- 2005 Franciscan (Napa Valley, California) 14/56 
Blackberry and cherry, with espresso, toast, spicy vanilla and sweet tobacco in the lingering finish.
- 2005 Conn Creek (Napa Valley, California) 15/60 
Plum, coffee and wood spice aromas with mocha chocolate flavors and dried cranberry leading to a bright cherry finish.
- 2006 Luigi Bosca Reserva (Maipu, Mendoza, Argentina) 15/60 
Juicy, with good plum and black currant fruit layered with vanilla-tinged toast.
- 2005 Ferrari-Carano (Alexander Valley, California) 16/64 
Aromas of blackberry syrup, boysenberry, spicy black currant, espresso, and caramel. Rich, delicious flavors of Bing cherry, chocolate, toffee and anise.
- 2005 Three Saints (Santa Ynez Valley, California) 16/64 
Aromas of blackberry and dark cherry accented by hints of mocha and sage. This dense and dark wine offers flavors of black fruit, wild berry and plum.
- 2005 Provenance Vineyards, Rutherford (Napa Valley, California) 17/68 
Notes of cherry, blackberry and mocha are contrasted with hints of mint and black tea. Palate of black fruit, caramel and chocolate flavors framed by beefy tannins.
- 2006 Frogs Leap (Napa Valley, California) 19/76 
Scents of black fruit and fresh herbs. Intense flavors of cassis, ripe plum and black currants, with hints of cedar and tobacco. Velvety tannins with light acidity.
- 2005 Atlas Peak (Napa Valley, California) 21/84 
Beautiful depth of color, and aromas of ripe, dark fruit with a touch of sweet vanilla.
- 2004 Heitz Cellar (Napa Valley, California) 22/88 
Dark cherry flavor, notes of vanilla and a touch of dried spice. Nicely balanced with bright acidity, this wine moves smoothly across the palate to an elegant finish.
- 2005 Watermark, Blue Hall Vineyard, (Howell Mountain, California) 22/88 
Exhibits cherry berry fruit complemented by vanilla and smoky oak tones.

- 2004 **Richard Perry, Perry Vineyards (Napa Valley, California)** 23/92 
Allspice, currant, cassis, blackberry and anise. On the palate, aromatic spices followed by a dark chocolate mocha. Fine-grain tannins finish with balance.
- 2003 **Kenwood Artist Series (Sonoma County, California)** 30/120 
Rich and deeply flavored, with spicy currant, plum and cherry flavors framed by spicy, buttery oak notes.
- 2003 **Heitz Cellar, Bella Oaks Vineyard (Napa Valley, California)** 32/128 
Bright flavor of cherry pie with a wisp of spice and the briary character of this wine unfold on the palate. Lean style, silky structure, and extended finish.
- 2004 **Mondavi Unfiltered Reserve (Oakville, Napa Valley, California)** 32/128 
Aromas of red berries, cassis, graphite and grilled nuts. Lush, sweet and mineral; displays compelling inner-mouth complexity and superb delineation.

Dark ruby color with aromas of black plum, chocolate, rose petals, cedar and black olive. Soft, velvety taste and a fruity, floral and spicy mid-palate. Long and smooth finish with well integrated tannins.

Medium bodied, juicy red with soft fruit aromas and flavors.
- 2006 **Belasco Llama (Mendoza, Argentina) 9/36**
Nose of violet and darkly roasted coffee. The palate offers sweet blackberry fruit with toasty oak and a continuation of the violet from the nose.
- 2008 **Callia Alta (San Juan, Argentina) 7/28** 
Bouquet with cherry, black pepper, hints of tobacco, cedar and tinge of leather. Good structure and balance, smooth and sour tastes dominate, mild tannins and oak.
- 2008 **Pascual Toso (Mendoza, Argentina) 8/32** 
Leads with an enticing cherry and blackberry nose. On the palate dark cherry, black plum and blueberry flavors. Fleshy texture with bright acidity.
- 2007 **Viña Obvio (Mendoza, Argentina) 8/32** 
Dark ruby color with pleasant notes of violet, a hint of mineral, and cherry.
- 2004 **Cavas y Almas del Amancay (Tupungato, Mendoza, Argentina) 9/36** 
Layers of ripe black cherry, plums, spice and tobacco. Well-structured, with ripe tannins and moderate acidity balancing the juicy fruit flavors.
- 2006 **Cueva de las Manos (Mendoza, Argentina) 10/40** 
Roasted pecan, chocolate and a little leather. Full-bodied, velvety, dark cherry with oak with a nice lingering finish. Ends on a slight fruity note.
- 2008 **Maipe (Mendoza, Argentina) 10/40** 
This Malbec has a deep purple color with violet tints, complex plum, fig, strawberry, spices and floral aromas; rounded and velvety tannins.
- 2006 **Mapema (Mendoza, Argentina) 10/40** 
Ripe and forward with dark licorice, fig, currant preserve and chocolate notes riding along round, rich tannins.
- 2008 **Trapiche "Broquel" (Mendoza, Argentina) 11/44** 
Dark fruits and jam with an elegant hint of smoke, vanilla and chocolate, while on the palate, it is ample and rich, with a long finish and delicate, soft tannins.
- 2008 **Don Miguel Gascón (Mendoza, Argentina) 11/44** 
Full bodied with blackberry, blueberry, plum, dark cherry and a hint of mocha notes and a velvety finish.
- 2007 **Michel Torino "Don David" Reserva (Cafayate Valley, Argentina) 11/44** 
Notes of cedar, spice box, mineral, cherry and black raspberry on its nose. The palate offers spicy flavors and a lengthy finish.

- 2006 Trivento Amado Sur (Mendoza, Argentina) 11/44 
Aromas of dark plum followed by smoke and vanilla. Rich, dense wine with a pleasing depth.
- 2007 DeCero Remolinos Vineyard (Agrelo, Mendoza, Argentina) 12/48 
Intense violet aromas and clarity of raspberry and red fruit.
- 2005 Belasco Guentota (Agrelo, Mendoza, Argentina) 13/52 
Lush, with juicy dark berry, plum and raisin flavors alongside deep toast and spice.
- 2007 Naiara (Mendoza, Argentina) 14/56 
Lots of red and black fruit on the nose and especially in the mouth, accompanied by a subtle earthiness, clove and violet.
- 2005 Inacayal Select (Mendoza, Argentina) 15/60 
Ripe and concentrated, with mint, blackberry, toast and spice notes from start to finish. Long, mocha-tinged finish.
- 2007 Tikal Amorio (Mendoza, Argentina) 15/60 
Aromas of smoky oak and cherry. Flavors of ripe red berries, red and black cherries. Rich and velvety on the palate.
- 2006 Bodega Catena Zapata (Mendoza, Argentina) 16/64 
Ripe plump fruit flavors, silky texture, dark fruit character and pepper notes, with black cherry aromas.
- 2006 Trapiche “Viña Adriana Venturin” (La Consulta, Mendoza, Argentina) 18/72 
Dark ruby-red color. Plum, violet pastille, licorice and a distinct note of chocolate on the nose.

Zinfandel

- 2006 **R and B Cellars Swingsville (Lodi, California) 9/36**
Bouquet shows fresh strawberry and raspberry with hints of pepper and spice. Flavors of ripe berry with creamy cherries and a spicy aftertaste.
- 2005 **Teira (Sonoma County, California) 8/32** 
Ripe strawberry, black cherry, blueberry pie, with vanilla spice and a hint of espresso on the nose. Taste of berry pie leading to a huge mouth feel.
- 2005 **Pezzi King (Dry Creek Valley, California) 10/40** 
Ruby - purple color, scents of ripe boysenberry, toasty oak, sweet vanilla and smoke. Full-bodied flavor of jammy black raspberry, pepper and truffle.
- 2007 **Four Vines "Old Vine Cuvee" (California) 13/52** 
On the nose the wine has layers of berry fruit and anise aromas with hints of spice. On the palate, blackberry and spicy plum fruit with a rich mouth feel trailing to a velvety toasted oak finish.
- 2007 **Seghesio (Sonoma County, California) 13/52** 
Smoky black cherry and blueberry aromas that lead to wild berry, sage and cracked pepper flavors, with a lingering finish and zesty tannins.
- 2005 **Clos LaChance Estate (Central Coast, California) 14/56** 
Wild blackberry and raspberry fruit aromas along with rose oil, with a hint of dill. Blueberry and blackberry jam flavors, touches of red cherry, sweet vanilla and oak spice on the finish.
- 2004 **Rued (Dry Creek Valley, California) 14/56** 
Aromas of blackberry and fresh baked cherry pie. Hints of licorice, cocoa and five spice linger in the background. Tastes of blackberry and dark fruits. Finishes with lingering cocoa and spice.
- 2007 **Frogs Leap (Napa Valley, California) 15/60** 
Tastes of wild berries and briary fruit, marked with a touch of spice. Bright acidity and slight earthy finish.
- 2007 **Rombauer (St. Helena, Napa Valley, California) 15/60** 
Bouquet of dark wild berries and cherries. Boysenberry and raspberry flavors.
- 2005 **Tandem Talmage Bench, Aldine Vineyard (Mendocino Cnty, California) 18/72** 
Cherries, blueberries and black raspberries run rampant, with overtones of milk chocolate and coffee. Rich, dusty tannins and great structure.
- 2006 **Gamba (Russian River Valley, California) 20/80** 
Nose of ripe berry fruits, mocha, anise, and spicy aromas. Dark stone fruit, plum, nectarine and dark berry flavors. Toasty oak and cedar tones.
- 2006 **Gann Family Cellars (Alexander Valley, California) 21/84** 
Deep claret color, aromas of blackberry and spice, and a lingering vanilla finish from the French oak.

Pinot Noir

- 2008 D'Arrigo (Italy) 7/28
Aromas of ripe dark fruit, silky smooth with a bright and beautiful mouth feel.
- 2006 MacMurray Ranch (Sonoma Coast, California) 8/32 
Concentrated fruit flavors of red and black fruits. Deep black cherry notes are complemented by subtle oak to add richness and depth to the finish.
- 2008 The Crossings (Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand) 10/40 
Nose offers delicate red berry fruits with violet and forest nuances before finishing with an infusion of darker cherry notes. High-toned fruit turns into a revealing palate and persistent finish.
- 2007 Cline Cashmere (California) 11/44 
Very flavorful, smooth wine offering big cherry, raspberry and chocolate notes with hints of cracked black pepper and plum.
- 2007 Erath (Oregon) 11/44 
Aromas of ripe strawberries, vanilla, graham cracker and a hint of caramel. A silky sweet entry leads to bright flavors of red currant, raspberry and orange peel. The finish is complemented by a pleasingly buoyant acidity.
- 2007 Hangtime (Burgundy, France) 11/44 
Well-balanced, intense flavors of red and black fruits, flowers and minerals. Complex character, vibrant flavors, and rich texture.
- 2008 Cartlidge and Browne (California) 12/48 
Aromas of cherry cider, plum jam, and spice cake. Vigorous and full-flavored, notes of cherry cobbler, fresh plum, and toffee.
- 2007 Edna Valley (San Luis Obispo County, California) 12/48 
Sweet floral notes, dark fruits, pungent spices. Medium body, medium acid; vanilla notes mesh well with dark berries, blueberries and toast.
- 2006 Whitehaven (Marlborough, New Zealand) 13/52 
Oak is evident on the nose and is well integrated with lifted fruits. Dominated by plums and dark cherries overlaid with violets. The palate is packed full of dark fruit with soft tannins and well-rounded acids.
- 2006 Kenneth Volk (Santa Maria Valley Cuvee, California) 14/56 
Deeply pigmented with aromas of ripe red fruits, toasted oak and Asian spices.
- 2007 Roots Estate (Yamhill-Carlton District, Oregon) 15/60 
Whiffs of dark and black fruits with hints of cola nuts. Flavors catch on the palate for a crisp finish.



Pinot Noir, cont.

- 2006 Orogeny (Green Valley, California) 17/68 
Bright cranberry and Bing cherry aromas with spice and cinnamon. Vibrant silky flavors mirror the aromas. Blackberry and toffee notes on a lingering finish.
- 2006 Siduri Arbre Vert Vineyard (Willamette Valley, Oregon) 17/68 
Displays ripe raspberry fruits along with hints of sweet plums and a creamy, vanilla flavored texture. The finish is long and distinguished.
- 2008 Zepaltas (Santa Rosa, California) 18/72 
Loamy earth, herb, sage and ripe plum and black cherry fruit is supple and complex, gaining depth and ending with a mix of mineral and fruit.
- 2007 Merry Edwards (Sonoma Coast, California) 19/76 
Aroma of this wine is packed with blueberry, black raspberry and Damson plums. It displays a floral, lupine perfume along with dark chocolate and cocoa. Undertones of spice, truffle and toasty oak.
- 2004 Woodenhead Buena Tierra Vineyard (Russian River Valley, California) 21/84 
Nose of brandied cherries, raspberries and cherry pie, with notes of rose petals, hibiscus, honeysuckle, and sweet oak. Finishes with green tea and supple tannins.
- 2006 Brogan Cellars (Russian River Valley, California) 24/96 
Aromas of cherry, cola, spice and smoked meats. Full of red fruits and spice.
- 2007 Sea Smoke "Southing" (Santa Rita Hills, California) 42/168 
Nose of dried and fresh flowers, then flavors of blueberries, fresh chanterelle, and a hint of guava. The broad mouthfeel and tannins are balanced by a cool climate acidity.

Syrah / Shiraz

- 2008 **Wilderness Estate (Australia) 7/28**
This full-bodied Shiraz exhibits aromas of dark plums and berries with a rich, flavorful palate.
- 2006 **Tapestry Baker's Gully Shiraz (Australia) 8/32** 
A bright crisp style with blackberry and floral flavors, framed by sweet oak lingering nicely.
- 2008 **Terra Barossa (Barossa Valley, South Australia) 9/36** 
Ruby-red. Spicy blackberry and blueberry on the nose, with licorice, espresso and fresh violet notes gaining volume with air. Dark fruit flavors display liqueur-like density. Finishes soft.
- 2005 **Hurrah Surrah (Paso Robles, California) 10/40** 
Dark burgundy color & very slightly fruity aroma. A mellow wine with some berry flavors.
- 2005 **Burgess Syrah (Napa Valley, California) 13/52** 
Pure, vibrant aromas of blackberries, blueberries, allspice, and sweet flowers, including a hint of gardenia. Vibrant acidity gives this wine a refreshing palate of crisp, ripe plum.
- 2008 **Shotfire (Barossa Valley, South Australia) 14/56** 
Saturated purple/black in color. Has a nose of wood smoke, bacon, mineral, and blueberry. Rich and intense on the palate, it has layers of flavor, excellent balance, and a pure finish.
- 2005 **Peter Lehmann Reserve Shiraz (Australia) 15/60** 
Deep garnet rim with a black center. Dark chocolate on the nose. This wine shows the classic richness of Barossa Shiraz with a superb depth of fruit on the middle palate. Fine chalky tannins on the finish.
- 2006 **Luca Syrah (Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina) 16/64** 
Aromas of black raspberry, blackberry, licorice and spicy, smoky oak, with a violet top note. Juicy, spicy and energetic with the flavors of black fruits, spices and black pepper.
- 2006 **LaFond Syrah (Santa Rita Hills, California) 17/68** 
Floral notes of lavender and a spicy element highlighted by distinct white pepper notes. Forward, dense floral character and dark fruit to complement the spicy components of the wine.
- 2004 **Unti Syrah (Dry Creek Valley, California) 17/68** 
Blackberry, cassis, fruit, with smoky, spicy complexity. Excellent depth, richness and balance. Layers of ripe plum, blackberry, wild berry, pepper and earth scents.
- 2005 **Richard Perry Syrah (Napa Valley, California) 20/80** 
Lush, intense and forward flavors of blackberry, dark chocolate, white pepper and spice in the nose. Juicy and rich up front, with ripe tannins and exceptional length.
- 2004 **Mi Sueño Syrah (Napa Valley, California) 25/100** 
Black fruits, violets and smoked meat aromas. Palate of ripe black fruit flavors and freshly roasted espresso.

Merlot

- 2007 **Domaine De Gournier (Vin de Pays Des Ceviennos, France) 8/32**
A bright, ripe, open red wine. Black fruit, tar, tobacco, earth, and black pepper on the nose. Luscious and jammy upfront, spilling over with black and red raspberries.
- 2006 **Fourteen Hands (Washington) 7/28 **
Classic Washington aromas of berries and black cherries. Ripe fruit flavors, subtle toast and mocha. Soft and approachable. Maintains a sturdy frame of tannins.
- 2005 **Rodney Strong (Sonoma County, California) 7/28 **
Plum and blueberry flavors, soft, rich, mouth-filling merlot; Toasty, spicy, vanilla, and a lingering berry finish.
- 2002 **Pavin & Riley (Columbia Valley, Washington) 8/32 **
Fine texture, with a juicy plum character in the middle, game around the edges and on the finish.
- 2007 **Graton (Sonoma County, California) 8/32 **
Cherry pie essence in the nose, with a sweet expression of fruit and oak. There is vanilla, caramel and cherries in the mouth, with a supple texture and a little warmth.
- 2007 **Grayson Cellars (California) 9/36 **
Aromas of black cherry and plum followed by layers light oak, cola and saffras and hints of wild raspberries. The inviting palate has bright flavors of cherry compote and spices with a balanced, supple finish.
- 2004 **Field Stone (Alexander Valley, California) 15/60 **
A nose rich and full of fruity depth with some oak. Palate of black fruit, but still giving off some red fruit and some Bing cherry on the long finish.
- 2007 **McMannis (California) 16/64 **
Fruit aromas of blackberry, blueberry, raspberry and cassis that are joined by notes of vanilla, hazelnut, milk chocolate and caramel.
- 2004 **Trefethen Estate (Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley, California) 16/64 **
Dark fruits of plum and blackberry combined with toast on the nose. The palate coats the mouth with rich, chewy and chalky tannins.
- 2007 **Natura Organic (Rapel Valley, Chile) 17/68 **
Deep ruby color. Attractive red fruit aroma of strawberries and raspberries with hints of toast and vanilla. Full and velvety with flavors of plum, cocoa and smoke, with smooth tannins and a firm, supple core.
- 2006 **Duckhorn (Napa Valley, California) 24/96 **
Mixed aromas of blueberry, raspberry and kirsch. A rush of black cherry fruit on entry, laced with mineral accents and fine-grain, youthful tannins. Creamy fruit marks the finish.


Other Red - North America

- 2006 Rabbit Ridge Red Blend (Paso Robles, California) 6/24 
Palate has light, forward fruits with raspberries being the most prevalent. Slightly peppery, simple finish.
- 2005 Boeger Vineyard Tempranillo (El Dorado, California) 8/32 
Nose of toasty oak, blackberry, fig, leather, tobacco, cedar. Tastes of blueberry, caramel, vanilla, and butter.
- 2005 Lot 205 Bordeaux Blend (California) 8/32 
This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petite Sirah provides ripe black fruit aromas with hints of sweet tobacco and cocoa.
- 2007 Guenoc Claret (North Coast, California) 9/36 
Powerful up-front dark fruit hits the palate immediately, followed by rich chocolate and a smooth long finish.
- 2006 Vinum Cellars Petite Sirah (Clarksburg, California) 9/36 
Deep Dark fruit. Velvety palate and rich earthy flavor. White pepper and cocoa on the finish.
- 2007 "Pets" Petite Sirah (Clarksburg, California) 9/36 
Bright and juicy red and black fruit flavors, with a smooth texture and vivid spice, cola and toast details. Gains some tannic traction on the finish.
- 2006 Greg Norman Petite Sirah (Central Coast, California) 10/40 
Scents of violet and raspberry tasting of juicy blackberry pie but also plum and dried fruit. It is rich and lush, with a light spice in the finish.
- 2006 Tablas Creek Cote de Tablas (Paso Robles, California) 12/48

Sweet, strawberry, candied cherries and some spice, a hint of cloves and ginger. Palate opens with sweet fruit, strawberry and cherries, but a firm mid-palate of smoke, cloves and ginger.
